Table for The Dataset of Determinant Factors towards the Ethical Values Attitudes of Health Workers when Providing Services in Government Hospitals

No	Determinant Factors	Description
1	Communication Skills (X ₁)	Part of the health worker's job is to convey something to the patient
2	Medical Knowledge/Skill (X ₂)	The main basis for a health worker in providing services
3	Ethics Education and Training (X ₃)	Hospital efforts to increase awareness in serving
4	Working Environment Conditions (X ₄)	The source of the atmosphere when health workers carry out their duties
5	Organizational Norms and Work Culture (X ₅)	The rules of the game apply and are binding on every health worker
6	Professional Responsibilities (X ₆)	A reflection of the identity that a health worker carries
7	Patient and Family Attitudes (X ₇)	Humanistic factors must be considered when interacting with non-hospital staff
8	Ethical Values of Health Workers (Y)	Reflections that health workers are able to show when providing services
